


## **Some Sad News**

### Winners, Finalists Named in 2020 AHR Expo Innovation Awards

Some of the most inventive and original products, systems and technologies that will be on display at the 2020 AHR Expo in Orlando, Fla., on Feb. 3–5 have been announced as winners and finalists for the annual AHR Expo Innovation Awards. Ten winners and 30 finalists were selected. The AHR Expo Product of the Year will be announced during the Expo.

### Research Group Develops High-Temperature Heat Pump

Researchers at Jaume I University in Spain have designed a functional heat pump that can recover industrial heat waste at high temperatures. The new prototype uses HFC-245fa refrigerant, which has a high critical temperature and can therefore produce steam or pressurized water up to 140 degrees C (284 degrees F). While this refrigerant has a high GWP, the new prototype will allow for further testing to be done with lower-GWP refrigerants. Read more

### Impact of Water Utility Rates on Chiller Selection

Historically, a water-cooled chiller plant would deliver lower utility costs than a similar air-cooled chiller plant. This article discusses a study that compared the utility expense of operating an air-cooled chiller plant versus a water-cooled chiller plant across eight climatic zones as identified in ASHRAE/IES Standard 90.1-2016. The focus is on utility costs to the owner and the role of energy modeling in making the best possible selection. Read More

### ACEEE Reports States' Progress Toward Clean Energy

The American Council for an Energy-Efficient Economy (ACEEE) has released its <u>2019 State Energy Efficiency Scorecard</u>, a progress report on state policies and programs that save energy while producing environmental and economic benefits. The report ranks states using six policy areas, and findings reveal that a rising number of states are showing leadership on clean energy by adopting ambitious goals and energy-saving rules for buildings, appliances and vehicles. <u>Read more</u> and <u>download the report here.</u>

### Study Shows That Daylight Levels Affect Thermal Perception

Researchers at Ecole Polytechnique Federale de Lausanne (EPFL) in Switzerland have shown that perception influences a person's thermal comfort. Participants in the experiment spent time in a room with three temperatures and three daylight illuminance levels. People in the coolest room reported being more comfortable when there was more daylight, even though their body temperature was the same when the room used little daylight. Read more
