ADAPT DSM

The City of Des Moines has adopted ambitious goals for energy efficiency and greenhouse gas reduction, including Net Zero by 2050. ASHRAE Iowa Chapter is participating in this effort as a member of the Technical Advisory Group for ADAPT DSM, the Climate Action and Adaptation Plan. This plan will guide decision making, policy, and program development to further the city's goals and address climate change.

Currently ADAPT DSM is in Phase 2, Goals & Solutions. A number of DRAFT solutions have been developed and can be viewed <u>here</u>. There are several ways that you can provide input and learn more:
